Note: Sgt at Arms Richard Merz made available pocket-sized copies of the US Constitution, Bill of Rights and Declaration of Independence to the membership.

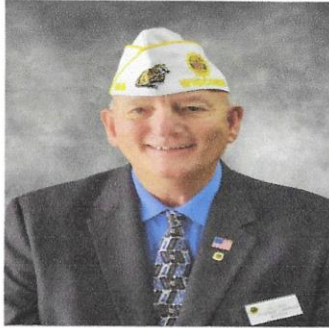
